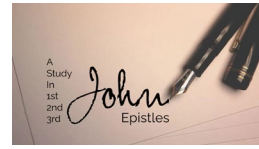

- **Jesus** is the light; walk in the light like Him; live from day to day changed by the Light.
- The **Holy Spirit** is aware of your thoughts before you even speak.
- John says that you don't have to sin; if you do sin, we have an Advocate/Helper at the Father's right hand.
- (1Jn 2:1) My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- **Jesus** is the propitiation for our sins, **He** has satisfied **God's** mandate for satisfaction.
- The mercy seat, where we receive mercy.
- Great tidings for **ALL** people; the love of **God**.
- We know that we love and know **Him** when we keep **His** commandments.
- **His** love is perfected in him that keeps **His** commandments. (v.5)
- Love the **Lord** our **God** with **ALL** that is about you! (v.7,8)
- **God** called the Jews, **His** people to be a light to the Gentiles (the world). (v.8)
- **God gave His Son to save the entire world! The light of Christ is shining.**
- **The light of God is the knowledge of God being applied.** (v.9,10)
- The gloom of the present evil and sin is giving way as the true **Light** is already shining. (v.11)
- Fathers that don't take of their children are like infidels/nonbelievers. Fatherhood is relational.
- The importance of mature teachings. The love of **Jesus** for others as **He** loved us.
- Being a part of the fellowship of **God** gives you something that DNA won't.
- (1Jn 2:15) Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.
- John warned against the desires of the body and what people work hard to acquire. (v.16)
- (1Jn 2:17) And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth forever.
- (1Jn 2:18) Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time.
- The antichrist here is anybody that denies who and what **Christ** is and has done.

- Followers of **Jesus Christ** ought to have explanation as to why they believe. (1 Pt. 3:15)
- Conduct that is against talking like **Jesus**; its not holy. What you practice is who you are.
- Their departure from the fellowship and from the truth was proof. (v.19)
- **Give the Lord your ALL.**
- The anointing from the **Holy One** is the **Holy Ghost; Christ/the Anointed.** (v.20)
- (1Jn 2:20) But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things.
- (Joh 10:27) My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:
- (Joh 10:29) My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.
- (1Jn 2:22) Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.
- False teaching, using other things instead of **God's** teachings.
- (1Jn 2:23) Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.
- (1Jn 2:24) Let that therefore abide in you, which ye have heard from the beginning. If that which ye have heard from the beginning shall remain in you, ye also shall continue in the Son, and in the Father.
- (1Jn 2:25) And this is the promise that He hath promised us, even eternal life.
- (1Jn 2:26) These things have I written unto you concerning them that seduce you.
- (1Jn 2:27) But the anointing which ye have received of Him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in Him.
- The anointing **God** has given you is teaching you; the **Comforter** will bring to your remembrance.
- The **Holy Ghost** will teach you all things that pertain to life; **God** will teach you.
- Do you know who's teaching you? The **Holy One**, the anointed teaching the anionite.
- Salvation is a matter of **God's** faithfulness, not our achievement.
