Study in the Book of Galatians:

Paul wrote this epistle/letter to the Galatians as an apostle!

- ***Read Acts 13 - 15***
- ***This may be Paul's earliest missionary letters, is also his most intense. It gives a strong presentation of the truth that sinners are justified and live godly lives by trusting in Jesus alone!***

Pastor's comments:

- ***Pray to recognize the message of the cross and the sacrifice of Jesus and God's plan of deliverance.***
- ***Jesus can be seen in the OT text from Genesis to Revelation.***
- ***Have panoramic view of the Word of God!***
- ***The LORD knows all things from the beginning to the end.***
- ***The image of GOD, the spiritual essence of GOD; concisely put is the essential and unique quality of human beings whereby we reflect and represent God in the context of meaningful relationship with Him, one another and the rest of creation.***
- ***GOD is Spirit and those who worship Him must do so in Spirit! (Jn.4:24)***
- ***GOD created ALL the races, giving different varieties/coats to them. (Gen. 1:27)***
- ***You are either saved or you are a sinner. (1Jn.3:1)***
- ***Having GOD'S view will allow us to come out okay!***

 - **Gospel message of unity**
 - **Bondage of the law**

 - **Law could not give eternal life; cleansed from sin.**

Chp. 3 Review:

(Galatians 3:19) Wherefore then serveth the law? It was added because of transgressions, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made; and it was ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator.

- Paul asked if the law was against the promise of **God**?

(Galatians 3:24) Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

- No, the law was our tutor/schoolmaster.

(Galatians 3:26) For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

- Sons of **God** through faith; eligible to receive fullness of inheritance

(Galatians 3:27) For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

- Baptism of the **Holy Ghost**; no man can provide! Covered/washed!
- Paul was discipled by **Jesus, Himself**.
- Discipleship is part of a follower of **Christ Jesus**.
- Abraham was not a Jew; when he believed on **God** he was not circumcised until he was 99 yrs. old; he believed and it was accounted to him as righteousness.

(Galatians 3:28) There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor

free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

- There is no distinction of races in **God's** teaching; man's prejudices.

(Galatians 4:1) Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all;

- As a child he is a "one day" you'll get but when he becomes a man he gets.

(Galatians 4:2) But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father.

(Galatians 4:3) Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world:

(Galatians 4:4) But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,

(Galatians 4:5) To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

- Everybody is under the law; spiritual slaves to sin.

(Galatians 4:6) And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father.

- **Jesus** came to redeem us but all will not be redeemed because they will not believe in the redemptive act of **Jesus Christ**.
- If **God** has not sent forth the **Spirit** in your heart you are not sons of **God**.

(Galatians 4:7) Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

- Jew or Gentile no longer a slave if the **Spirit of God** dwells in you.
- He who is justified by faith in **Christ** is a son, with full rights as an heir to **God's** infinite treasures.
- Thank **God** for His promises of freedom through **Christ Jesus**.
