- You must (need) have spiritual knowledge to not be caught up in others ignorant suggestions.
- Get the **full** counsel of the **Word of God!**
- Be careful!! Know genuine worship

### **Review Chp. 5:**

(Galatians 5:16) This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

- There is internal struggle against strong desires of the flesh.
- Our inclination is not to obey **God** but to listen to the flesh.
- Outside the perfect will of **God** our sinful nature yet remains.
- The **Holy Spirit** keeps us by **His** power from the control of sin.

(Galatians 5:17) For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit

against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.

- (James 1:12) Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him. (12-15)
  - What happens when we sin; there is a process that takes place.
  - Result of committing sin that is death.
  - We have made alive in **Christ**; being in a deadly condition and it be okay is a problem.
- (2 Corinthians 5:17) Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- If we sin, we have an **Advocate** with the **Father**; you don't have to sin.

(Galatians 5:18) But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.

(Galatians 5:19) Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,

(Galatians 5:20) Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,

(Galatians 5:21) Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

- These are categories, there are many more and the "s" means they are not one dimensional.
- Those that **practice** these things are evidence that one is not saved.
- These are about the world, the flesh.

(Galatians 5:22) But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

(Galatians 5:23) Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

- These attributes of **God** belong to us in the fullness of living; your recreation in **Christ** is a result of the fruit of **His** death at Calvary.
- If the fruit of the **Spirit** don't exist in you then you are not **His**.
- (John 14:18) I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.
- (Hebrews 13:5b) for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake

thee.

- Before action takes place, it (sin) must first conquer your mind.
- Job's hedge was his faith in **God**, his trust in **God**.
- The adversary does not know **God** like he thinks he does; doesn't understand **faith** in **God**.
- (Philippians 2:5) Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:
- (Romans 12:1) I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

(Galatians 5:24) And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.

(Galatians 5:25) If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

- Walking; how you live your day to day. How you walking?

(Galatians 5:26) Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.

- Conceited in what we think we have and that others don't in the **Lord**.
- Not to think more highly of ourselves, provoking others.
- Your actions affect others in ways that cause the weak in faith to stumble. Doing things for others will help you to do better.
  - **God** looked beyond our faults; **He** rescues our mind.
  - **The Word is the salvation suppling living Word of God!**
- (Romans 12:2) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- (Isaiah 53:5b) and with his stripes we are healed.
- Resurrection living.

(Galatians 6:1) Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

- Instructions for only those are spiritual if that's not you leave it alone.
- Do you have a genuine relationship with **God**?
- Never look down on anybody.
- We ought to have a spirit of forgiveness.
- (Matthew 18:22) Jesus saith unto him, I say not unto thee, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven.

- Restore as long as you have a heart to forgive.
- The trespasser needs to have a restoring/reconciler heart.
- It is non-Jesus to have disunity in the church, it is unacceptable to **God**.
- Honor the **Word of God**.

- Be transformed by the renewing of your mind.....do not conform to this world and its minions.
