Study in the Book of Isaiah

Pastor's Review:

Chp. 43:

(Isa 43:1) But now thus saith the LORD that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine.



Isaiah

Display God's love highlighted even in Israel continued disobedience.

(Isa 43:14) Thus saith the LORD, your redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; For your sake I have sent to Babylon, and have brought down all their nobles, and the Chaldeans, whose cry is in the ships.

(Isa 43:19) Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.

(Isa 43:20) The beast of the field shall honour me, the dragons and the owls: because I give waters in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert, to give drink to my people, my chosen.

- Remember not the former things; God will do wonderful things.
- This is a time of rest, relief for His chosen.
- God will do marvelous things He will do.
- How will you show His taking care of you?

(Isa 43:25) I, even I, am he that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins.

(Isa 43:26) Put me in remembrance: let us plead together: declare thou, that thou mayest be justified.

- No honor given to God the way He instructed it; but by grace unmerited, unearned, not worthy however, He forgives.
- Jesus is woven into all of Scriptures.

Chp. 44:

(Isa 44:1) Yet now hear, O Jacob my servant; and Israel, whom I have chosen:

(Isa 44:2) Thus saith the LORD that made thee, and formed thee from the womb, which will help thee; Fear not, O Jacob, my servant; and thou, Jesurun, whom I have chosen.

(Isa 44:3) For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring:

(Isa 44:4) And they shall spring up as among the grass, as willows by the water courses.

(Isa 44:5) One shall say, I am the LORD'S; and another shall call himself by the name of Jacob; and another shall subscribe with his hand unto the LORD, and surname himself by the name of Israel.

Good to know that you are servant of the Most High God, His chosen.



Isaiah

- God's Chosen will receive these blessings.
- (Mat 11:28) Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- (Pro 22:6) Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.
- Promises of Scripture; training intricately instructs the details learned.
- The Spirit of God will motivate your actions.
- Do you belong to God?

(Isa 44:6) Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.

(Isa 44:7) And who, as I, shall call, and shall declare it, and set it in order for me, since I appointed the ancient people? and the things that are coming, and shall come, let them shew unto them.

(Isa 44:8) Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? ye are even my witnesses. Is there a God beside me? yea, there is no God; I know not any.

(Isa 44:9) They that make a graven image are all of them vanity; and their delectable things shall not profit; and they are their own witnesses; they see not, nor know; that they may be ashamed.

- He is the LORD of the great host; Jesus described here!
- (Rev 1:8) I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.
- No God exists beside God! Our God is a Rock!
- (Rom 1:20) For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:
- Because there is creation there must be a Creator; design = Designer.
- The Word of God is divinely inspired.

(Isa 44:10) Who hath formed a god, or molten a graven image that is profitable for nothing?

(Isa 44:11) Behold, all his fellows shall be ashamed: and the workmen, they are of men: let them all be gathered together, let them stand up; yet they shall fear, and they shall be ashamed together.

(Isa 44:15) Then shall it be for a man to burn: for he will take thereof, and warm himself; yea, he kindleth it, and baketh bread; yea, he maketh a god, and worshippeth it; he maketh it a graven image, and falleth down thereto. (Isa 44:20) He feedeth on ashes: a deceived heart hath turned him aside, that he cannot deliver his soul, nor say, Is there not a lie in my right hand?



Isaiah

- The argument against idols begins with an assertion of the uniqueness of Yahweh; not the false gods of the nations.
- Speaks to the absurdity of idolatry.

(Isa 44:24) Thus saith the LORD, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I am the LORD that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself; (Isa 44:26) That confirmeth the word of his servant, and performeth the counsel of his messengers; that saith to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be inhabited; and to the cities of Judah, Ye shall be built, and I will raise up the decayed places thereof:

(Isa 44:27) That saith to the deep, Be dry, and I will dry up thy rivers: (Isa 44:28) That saith of Cyrus, He is my shepherd, and shall perform all my pleasure: even saying to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be built; and to the temple, Thy foundation shall be laid.

- Repeatedly God redeems His people.
- God reminds Israel of their provisions made by Him over and over.
- Jesus announced the agent of His rescue of exiled Jerusalem-Cyrus the Great, who was even born yet.
- Foretelling of coming events; God uses an unbeliever to do His will.
- Know that Jesus loves you for sure.
