**Father, help me to choose devotion to You over distraction!
(Luke 10:41)**

Pastor's Review:

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- The Bible says **God** is not respecter of person.
- **God** chose Israel because **He** wanted to and for them to be a light for the Gentiles; not sanctified away from the world; to be the station from which the **Messiah** was to come.
- **God showing you there is nothing different about Israel than there is about you.**
- **Israel is an example by which God shows you and the rest of the world that this fallen, sinful mankind.**
- **Main purpose is to bring you, the world to Jesus Christ; needs to take place to bring the revelation of Jesus Christ.**
- (Deu 7:8) But because the LORD loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt.
- (Deu 7:9) Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;
- Every aspect of Scripture brings you to **Jesus Christ** throughout the Bible; to bring the world to **Christ Jesus.**
- **Jesus is woven in all these 66 books! Righteousness**
- Righteousness complete; faithfulness to God complete; joy complete; happiness complete; it will be **Christ** each and every time.

Review:

Chp.11:

(Isa 11:1) And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots:

(Isa 11:2) And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;

- **God** saying after all the upheaval there will be a way out; this family tree of Jesse, David's father there would be a rod, a stem, a branch.

(Isa 11:6) The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them.

(Isa 11:7) And the cow and the bear shall feed; their young ones shall lie down together: and the lion shall eat straw like the ox.

- A time when natural enemies will be at peace living together.

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(Isa 11:10) And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be glorious.

(Isa 11:11) And it shall come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from Pathros, and from Cush, and from Elam, and from Shinar, and from Hamath, and from the islands of the sea.

(Isa 11:12) And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

- This after **Jesus Christ** has come; there were Gentiles.
- (Rom 3:29) Is he the God of the Jews only? is he not also of the Gentiles? Yes, of the Gentiles also:
- Many were looking for Jesus after **His** crucifixion.
- **Jesus Christ** fills all the boxes;
- Our faith is just not religion it is a lifestyle and a living.
- God will come to get **His** remnant.
- Outcast: outside the "pail" of Judaism.

(Isa 11:16) And there shall be an highway for the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria; like as it was to Israel in the day that he came up out of the land of Egypt.

- The manner in which **God** parted the Red Sea this will be that spectacular; a highway for you.
- **He is the same yesterday, today and forever.**
- The same "rod" Moses used at the Red Sea, will be used for you.

Chp. 12:

(Isa 12:1) And in that day thou shalt say, O LORD, I will praise thee: though thou wast angry with me, thine anger is turned away, and thou comfort me.

(Isa 12:2) Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation.

- Salvation= deliverance, highway, way out!!!

(Isa 12:4) And in that day shall ye say, Praise the LORD, call upon his name,

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declare his doings among the people, make mention that his name is exalted.

(Isa 12:5) Sing unto the LORD; for he hath done excellent things: this is known in all the earth.

(Isa 12:6) Cry out and shout, thou inhabitant of Zion: for great is the Holy One of Israel in the midst of thee.

- Shout out "**Amen.**"
- The **Lord** would have you to remember what **He** has done in your life!
- Whatever you go thru remember..." in that day."
- Authentic praise are points of reference, where you go for refuge to be secure.
- Praise **God** with "halleluiah=Praise the **Lord (Yah-the Lord)**!
- Trust in **God** with all your heart.

Chp. 13:

(Isa 13:2) Lift ye up a banner upon the high mountain, exalt the voice unto them, shake the hand, that they may go into the gates of the nobles.

(Isa 13:3) I have commanded my sanctified ones, I have also called my mighty ones for mine anger, even them that rejoice in my highness.

(Isa 13:17) Behold, I will stir up the Medes against them, which shall not regard silver; and as for gold, they shall not delight in it.

(Isa 13:18) Their bows also shall dash the young men to pieces; and they shall have no pity on the fruit of the womb; their eye shall not spare children.

(Isa 13:19) And Babylon, the glory of kingdoms, the beauty of the Chaldees' excellency, shall be as when God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah.

- Point and time of calamity.
- These events resemble the state of our world right now; a point in time for **God's** people.
- Know your eternal destiny.
- The object of **God's** wrath is pride that leads people to trust in themselves rather than in **Him**.
- Only a fool says in his heart there is no **God**.

(Isa 13:20) It shall never be inhabited, neither shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation: neither shall the Arabian pitch tent there; neither shall the shepherds make their fold there.

(Isa 13:21) But wild beasts of the desert shall lie there; and their houses shall be full of doleful creatures; and owls shall dwell there, and satyrs shall

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dance there.

(Isa 13:22) And the wild beasts of the islands shall cry in their desolate houses, and dragons in their pleasant palaces: and her time is near to come, and her days shall not be prolonged.

- A time of desolation of nations; what a time!

(Isa 14:1) For the LORD will have mercy on Jacob, and will yet choose Israel, and set them in their own land: and the strangers shall be joined with them, and they shall cleave to the house of Jacob.

(Isa 14:2) And the people shall take them, and bring them to their place: and the house of Israel shall possess them in the land of the LORD for servants and handmaids: and they shall take them captives, whose captives they were; and they shall rule over their oppressors.

(Isa 14:3) And it shall come to pass in the day that the LORD shall give thee rest from thy sorrow, and from thy fear, and from the hard bondage wherein thou wast made to serve,

(Isa 14:5) The LORD hath broken the staff of the wicked, and the sceptre of the rulers.

(Isa 14:7) The whole earth is at rest, and is quiet: they break forth into singing.

(Isa 14:8) Yea, the fir trees rejoice at thee, and the cedars of Lebanon, saying, Since thou art laid down, no feller is come up against us.

- Trees talking....they will rejoice, happy.

(Isa 14:9) Hell from beneath is moved for thee to meet thee at thy coming: it stirreth up the dead for thee, even all the chief ones of the earth; it hath raised up from their thrones all the kings of the nations.

(Isa 14:10) All they shall speak and say unto thee, Art thou also become weak as we? art thou become like unto us?

(Isa 14:12) How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

(Isa 14:13) For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north:

- This is a true horror story; hell is coming to meet you excited.
- Hell, the dead are weak compared to **God**; are you dead?
- It is terrible for those who are outside **His** will.
- The name Lucifer=the lighted one, luminous.
- **God** made him beautiful.

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- Demon is a description of an evil spirit; they look good.
- Presents himself as light; but he is a fallen angel.

(Isa 14:14) I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.

(Isa 14:15) Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.

(Isa 14:16) They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, Is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms;

- The pit is nowhere on earth. Cast into the lake of fire...(Rev. 20)
- Faith provides that which we cannot provide for ourselves.
- **God** will not forsake us.
- (Job 1:21) And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.
