## ***Study in the Gospel of Matthew:***

Study in the Book of Matthew verse by verse is helpful for clarity.

- Matthew/Levi; formerly known as tax collector, "Gift of God"

### **Review: Pastor's comments & Review:**

**Matthew-the Gospel of the Kingdom of God: The Kingdom of heaven is like.....**

### **Chp. 22 Review:**

(Matthew 22:17) Tell us therefore, What thinkest thou? Is it lawful to give tribute unto Caesar, or not?

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(Matthew 22:18) But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, Why tempt ye me, ye hypocrites?

(Matthew 22:21) They say unto him, Caesar's. Then saith he unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God the things that are God's.

- **Jesus** said the coin ultimately belonged to the one whose image it bears, and since we bear **God's** image all we have belongs to **Him**.
- Take care of civil responsibilities, however don't neglect your spiritual responsibilities.
- What does **God** require above everything? **God** requires you!
- Physical things are a representation of you.

(Matthew 22:23) The same day came to him the Sadducees, which say that there is no resurrection, and asked him,

(Matthew 22:29) Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God.

- Sadducees believed that life ceased at the moment of physical death. (Acts 23:8); Material things related to hell.
- Pharisees believed in resurrection of the dead, a literal resurrection of the physical body, reunited with the spirit. (Acts 23:6)
- **Jesus** admonished them for their ignorance of scripture and **God**.
- Born-again; not trying to get into heaven, your best isn't good enough, know scripture for yourself and apply it to your life.
- As we overcome the weaknesses of the flesh, we exhibit the power of **God** to overcome; stumbling is never falling.
- (Ephesians 3:20) Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

(Matthew 22:32) I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.

- Angels do not have babies and cannot make themselves human-they are not **God!**
- **God is the God of the living.**

(Matthew 22:35) Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him a question, tempting him, and saying,

(Matthew 22:36) Master, which is the great commandment in the law?

(Matthew 22:37) Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

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(Matthew 22:38) This is the first and great commandment.

(Matthew 22:39) And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

(Matthew 22:40) On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

- **Jesus** said the greatest thing is to love the **Lord**, when you do you will be loving your neighbor as yourself.
- We are learning to love like **God** loves.
- Be awakened to how we are with each other.
- Every aspect of our living that is not like **Him** stinks to **Him** but **Jesus** doesn't move away from us.
- Do you realize your own wickedness?
- **Jesus** teaching what love really is even to those who knew scripture.
- (Matthew 19:22) But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions.
- To know what to do and not do it is ignorance.
- Our **Lord and Savior** comes as the very expression of **God's** love;
- Jesus teaches how can we love God whom we've never seen and hate the one we do see.
- (Mark 12:30) And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment.

(Matthew 22:41) While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them,

(Matthew 22:42) Saying, What think ye of Christ? whose son is he? They say unto him, The Son of David.

(Matthew 22:43) He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord, saying,

(Matthew 22:44) The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool?

(Matthew 22:45) If David then call him Lord, how is he his son?

- **Jesus** emphasized repeatedly their ignorance of scripture; **He** knew because **Jesus** had been taught by them.
- God sent Jesus so folk would not stay ignorant.
- (1 Corinthians 12:1) Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not have you ignorant.
- **Jesus** came to bring light to darkness; **THIS IS THE LOVE OF GOD!**
- Read scripture, the main things are the plain things.

## Chp. 23 Woe to the Sadducees and Pharisees:

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(Matthew 23:1) Then spake Jesus to the multitude, and to his disciples,

(Matthew 23:2) Saying, The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat:

(Matthew 23:3) All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do; but do not ye after their works: for they say, and do not.

(Matthew 23:4) For they bind heavy burdens and grievous to be borne, and lay them on men's shoulders; but they themselves will not move them with one of their fingers.

- Read parable of the Two Sons (22:28-32)
- They had obedience to their leaders who were not **Christ Jesus**.
- Putting burdens on people that they themselves were not under.
- The truth of the **Word of God**.
- Conclusion: The Pharisees, Sadducees & Scribes loved being called "Reverend this and Dr. that"-loving the platform people put them on.
