## Pastor's Review:

### Chp. 24:36-44

- Teachings of **Jesus** of the **end times** that followers can look to relative to **His** second coming.
- Jesus followers should live in a state of constant preparedness.
- **Jesus** teaches the parable of the **fig tree** which had leaves but produced no fruit
- There are plenty of churches with leaves, but what about the fruit?
- Be ready; looking up; will come like a thief... (**1Thess. 5:2**)

### Chp. 25:8-13

- Parable of 5 wise virgins (who had extra oil) and 5 foolish virgins (who didn't have enough oil).
- Are you prepared with extra oil? Situations will come to see if you have any oil left.
- **Oil in Scripture signifies the Holy Spirit.**

### v. 14-30:

- Parable of the talents; gifts given to stewards of **Jesus**.
- Do hide your gift in the ground? Do you know your **Master**, what's required of your stewardship?
- Faithful servants of **God** (true disciples) use gifts responsibly.

### v. 31-46:

- **Jesus** gives description of the final judgment.
- The **King, Jesus** will judge people based on their reception and treatment of the least of **His** brethren.
- All nations will be gathered, **He** will separate the sheep from the goats.
- Sheep and goats sound alike sometime-the **Shepherd** knows.
- The conduct of a believer; standards by which you will be judged.
- Treatment of **Jesus'** representatives expresses love for and commitment to **Jesus Himself**.
- Not all people look, dress or smell like us so be careful not to look down on any man except to give them a hand up.
- Lazarus at the rich man's table...(Lk. 16:20-26)
- The main issues of the kingdom of **God**.
- Details laced in the narrative of the Gospel of Matthew.



## Chp. 26:1-5 The Plot to Kill Jesus:

- The time in the days of **Jesus** different from our current way of time.
- **Jesus** gave prophecy on Tuesday regarding the Passover, “and the **Son of Man** will be delivered up to be crucified.” (v.1-2)
- You can’t trick **God-He** already wrote down what was to happen!
- The leadership feared the people not **God**; a riot would affect them.
- **Jesus** was taking the adulation and glory away from the leadership.
- **Jesus’** miracles had resulted in many followers.
- **All glory goes to God; anything else crucifies Him afresh!**

## v. 6-13:

- The woman, Mary (**Jn. 12:3**) fragrant oil was a year’s wages.
- She anointed **Jesus’** head recalled anointing in OT (**1 Sam.10:1**).
- Memorial to her; who and what she did. Used her hair to glorify **Jesus**.
- The woman showed her gratitude to the **LORD!**
- How do you show your gratitude to **God?**
- Are you obedient from your heart?
- Justice, mercy and grace finds its demonstration from a genuine relationship with **God**.
- **Jesus’** position at the table. (**Mk. 14:3; Jn. 12:3; Lk. 7:36-44**)

## v. 14-19:

- Judas agrees to portray **Jesus**; earning thirty pieces of silver was only a third of the cost of the oil Mary had anointed **Jesus’** head
- **Jesus** uses supernatural knowledge. (**Mk. 14:13-19**)
- Last Passover meal: details that the disciples reflected back on.
- Strange sight to see a man carrying water a chore women performed. (**Lk. 22: 7-12**)
- Sometimes **God** will have **His** servants do usual things. We ought to want to be good servants to our **Lord**.
- Where will you lead someone that follows you back to the house?
- **Jesus** said, “I go to prepare a place for you”...(Jn. 14:2)
- We have the instructions to follow... (**THE BIBLE!**)

## v. 21-25:

- **Jesus** with the twelve disciples prophesied **God’s** plan, the betrayal predicted by **Scripture**. (**Mk. 9:12**)

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- They all acted like they were sorrowful; the betrayal was taking place; what are the things that stay on your mind with nothing to intercede?
- **God** will never leave you in a state of betrayal when you belong to **Him**.
- David and Bathsheba...(2Sam.11: 3-26); Nathan **God's** oil..(12: 1-15)

### v. 26-31:

- **Jesus'** serves Passover meal to the disciples:
  - The **Bread** symbolized **Jesus'** body which would be torn by scourging and crucifixion; the cup symbolized **Jesus'** blood.
  - The law of Moses had forbidden consuming blood.
  - **Jesus'** sacrifice enacted the promised new covenant. (**Jere. 31**)
- When you let the power of **God** bless others by your actions there will be a difference; some chose to stay dead not receive the reward.
- **God** vowed to forgive and forget **His** people' sins; promised to write **His** law on the hearts of **His** people, they can fulfill **His** righteousness.
- They beat **Jesus**, naked and bleeding from **His** head to **His** feet.
- "til **HE** comes"..(1 Cor. 11:26)
- **Jesus** encourages them that this is not the end!
- "Eyes have not seen"....(1 Cor. 2: 9)
- Details in Scripture make sense.
- **Jesus** viewed **His** death ultimately as the fulfillment of **God's** righteous plan. (**Acts 2:23; 4:27-28**)
- To separate the **Shepard** from the sheep...(Mk. 14: 27; Zech. 13:7)
- **God** shares **His Word** with all who hear it, when judgment comes there will be no excuses.
- The **Holy Spirit** will bring back the things **He** prophesied
