Pastor's Comments:

- Reading, praying and meditating are helpful in living for Christ Jesus.
- The bible has both literal and spiritual meaning and application; don't over spiritualize taking it out of context.
- Carefully and critically listen to any person standing before you to teach the Word of God.
- Glorify God not men!
- Don't use your experience as the standard instead take it and let the Word of God be the arbitrator.
- "New birth" means partnership with the Holy Spirit.
- Weigh things on God's scale; His is never unbalanced.
- (Ephesians 5:15) See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise,
- (1 Peter 5:7) Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.
- (Matthew 11:30) For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.



Study in the Gospel of Matthew:

Study in the Book of Matthew verse by verse is helpful for clarity.

Review: Pastor's Comments

- In the "last days" there will be perilous times and false doctrine being taught.
- False teachers will be a great weapon used by the adversary
- Don't use error taught by others as the power of God.
- The **Lord's** blessing enumerated: (Ps. 103:1-5)
- Edification, enlightened more, draw closer in our relationship
- Pastor's job description: Titus 1:5
- We need the full counsel of the Word of God!
- Pastor's (good) correct, check and stop errors. When anything is exercised in a group of believers and is in error it should be addressed.
- Only God spoke things into existence: Rom. 4:16-17
- God teaches genuine faith in Him will accomplish according to His will-our example is Christ Jesus.
- These are life and death issues-PAY ATTENTION!!
- (Ephesians 6:12) For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Chp. 9:

(Matthew 9:2) And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee.

(Matthew 9:6) But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house.

(Matthew 9:8) But when the multitudes saw it, they marvelled, and glorified

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God, which had given such power unto men.

- **Jesus** had supernatural knowledge of their thoughts.
- **Jesus** proved **His** authority to forgive sins by removing the physical consequences of sin.
- **Jesus** saw the faith of the man's friends who had heard about **Him**.
- Be encouraged by people who love you; lift them up, take up your end and take it to **Jesus**.
- **Jesus** associated **His** power with **His** identity. (Isa. 53 & Dan. 7)

(Matthew 9:13) But go ye and learn what that meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

- (Hosea 6:6) For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings.
- (Matthew 5:7) Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.
- (Proverbs 4:5) Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth.
- You cannot get understanding unless you get knowledge.

(Matthew 9:15) And Jesus said unto them, Can the children of the bridechamber mourn, as long as the bridegroom is with them? but the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken from them, and then shall they fast.

- Fasting was never used during times of joy and happiness, always used in times of distress and devotion to **God** praying and meditation.
- The presence of the **Messiah** gave the disciples an irrepressible joy that was inconsistent with fasting.

(Matthew 9:16) No man putteth a piece of new cloth unto an old garment, for that which is put in to fill it up taketh from the garment, and the rent is made worse.

(Matthew 9:17) Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish: but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.

- Incompatibility of traditional Jewish teaching and **Jesus'** teaching.
- The newness of the gospel would not fit.
- The old wineskins cannot hold eternal life.
- Cure for sin is not found in animal sacrifice.

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- Wine of the New Covenant; Jesus' blood that was shed that gives eternal life.
- New Wineskin-the Body of Christ!
- Both were preserved The Wine and the Wineskin
