Pastor's Comments:

- Reading, praying and meditating are helpful in living for Christ Jesus.
- The bible has both literal and spiritual meaning and application; don't over spiritualize taking it out of context.
- Carefully and critically listen to any person standing before you to teach the Word of God.
- Glorify God not men!
- Don't use your experience as the standard instead take it and let the Word of God be the arbitrator.
- "New birth" means partnership with the Holy Spirit.
- Weigh things on God's scale; His is never unbalanced.
- (Ephesians 5:15) See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise,
- (1 Peter 5:7) Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.
- (Matthew 11:30) For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.
- Pray your coming to study the Word of God will not be in vain but be fruitful and beneficial to equip you in the Lord.



Study in the Gospel of Matthew:

Study in the Book of Matthew verse by verse is helpful for clarity.

Review: Pastor's comments

(Matthew 11:25) At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.

 When being taught, pray to God for spiritual receptors that only He can provide to fight the adversary and to become closer to our God.

Chp. 12: Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath

(Matthew 12:24) But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, This fellow doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils.

• Jesus was accused of casting evil spirits by the power of evil.

(Matthew 12:25) And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand:

- **Jesus** argued that Satan is too smart to undermine his own kingdom.
- They had themselves claimed to cast out demons.
- A nation against itself cannot stand.

(Matthew 12:28) But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

(Matthew 12:29) Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house.

 Strong man stands to defend itself and must be overcome; evil spirits can't overcome the Spirit/Holy Ghost.

(Matthew 12:30) He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad.

• No gray areas.



- (1 Corinthians 10:13) There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.
- We don't have to give in to temptation leading to sin.
- Get the Word of God in you in the way of defending your faith.

(Matthew 12:31) Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men.

- The unpardonable sin; God will not pardon blasphemy against the Holy Spirit.
- Dismissing Jesus' supernatural power would not be forgiven because it expressed a resolute, permanent rejection of Jesus.
- (Romans 5:10) For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.
- You will have a tendency to be like who you follow.

Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath:

(Matthew 12:8) For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.

- What's more important, ceremony or you?
- (Matthew 12:7) But if ye had known what this meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless.
- Jesus taught that Sabbath law was overridden by human priorities. ie: David ate the showbread from the temple that was left for priests. (1Sam.21:6)
- Self-blindness; God said you are damned calling the work of the Holy Spirit the devil's work.
- Pray for spiritual discernment which is a critical characteristic for Christians.
- (1 John 4:1) Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
- Find out what **God** hates then agree.
- (Proverbs 6:16) These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him:
- (Psalms 16:2) O my soul, thou hast said unto the LORD, Thou art my Lord: my goodness extendeth not to thee;
- (James 1:17) Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and



cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

- Without God you can do nothing; what God created was good (Gen. 1:31)
- Because of man's free-will they deny redemption; they love darkness more than light. Walk in the light as **Jesus** is the light.

(Matthew 12:33) Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit.

- (1 Timothy 4:2) Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;
- Their evil words revealed the true nature of their hearts.
- Jesus the very power of God put on flesh & blood in the Person of Jesus, showing how to love as God loves.

(Matthew 12:34) O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.

• **Jesus** spoke the very words John the Baptist had spoken.

(Matthew 12:35) A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.

- Jesus uses Himself, checking His speech and what He had done and it was all good.
- What makes a man good or evil is where his treasure (heart) is.
- Where is your treasure? Check your treasures.

(Matthew 12:36) But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. (Matthew 12:37) For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

- The "born again" Christian doesn't practice living the wrong way.
- It is what you live out practice continually.
- (1 Peter 1:14) As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance:
- (1 Peter 1:15) But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;

(Matthew 12:38) Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered,



saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee. (Matthew 12:39) But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas:

- The Ninevites were not Jews that were Gentiles who had repented and sought the truth.
- The Jewish leaders had already witnessed several of **Jesus**' miracles. (vv. 9-14; 9:1-8)
- No sign would be given but **Jesus'** crucifixion & resurrection.
- (Psalms 136:1) O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.
